## PaleoJoe

### *Paleontologist*

Join Paleontologist, Author, Storyteller, and Dinosaur Hunter - PaleoJoe as he takes you on a wild ride through our prehistoric past. Michigan was once covered by a shallow inland sea over 350 million years ago. Visit the ancient tropical seas of Michigan and explore the creatures that once lived here; see Trilobites that once roamed the sea floor and the famous corals we now know as Petoskey Stone. Learn about the critical role rivers and lakes play in the process of dinosaur fossil preservation. Join PaleoJoe for an exciting, educational and entertaining journey.

## Capt'n Willie

### *The Great Lakes Pirate*

It's time to get silly with Capt'n Willie and learn something too! Capt'n Willie, the Great Lakes Pirate, will take you on an adventure on the tall ship called Knowledge and share his treasures with you! Ye best believe that beauties, scurvydogs an' landlubbers on deck will be sure t' have a swashbucklin' good time while gettin' silly with Capt'n Willie an' learnin' somethin' too!

## Michael Deren – The Past in Person

### *Historical Program*

*The Past in Person* programs are historical, musical, educational and audience-involving. Michael is an accomplished musician, songwriter and storyteller. Journey into the past through the music, songs and words of the common people whose labor built America.

1. *The Canal Boat Captain of 1840* takes you on a musical journey from Albany, New York to the Michigan wilderness via the newly built Erie Canal. He plays the banjo, concertina and penny whistle and shares songs and stories of the canal as well as teaching about the beginnings of the state of Michigan.
2. *The Lumberjack / Shanty Boy of the 1870's* from Northern Michigan plays concertina, fiddle, bones and button accordion and recreates life in the Michigan lumber camps. He shares songs and stories of daily life and work in the camps and the importance of the lumber industry.
3. *The Schooner Captain of 1875* takes the audience on a voyage of music and history of the Great Lakes. Using accordion and concertina he shares the songs, stories, history and resources of the Great Lakes region. Topics include geography, transportation, history (beaver, lumber, fishing, iron and copper) and conservation.

## Paul Roose

### *Naturalist Program*

Dive into Michigan's wetlands with professional naturalist Paul Roose. Find out what's hidden inside 'Touch and Guess' discovery boxes.
